ENHANCEMENTS

Kerlink Device Support – Automatically sync device name from Kerlink to EarthRanger and add support for multiple device types

Legacy Sunset Message – Added message about the removal of support for the Legacy User Interface at the end of September

FIXES

GPX Data Import – Improved the resiliency of GPX data imports for files without trackpoints or dates

Subject Clusteing Popup – When clicking a cluster of subjects located at the same location, the available subjects are now sorted by subject

Feed Sort – Fixed issue in the feed that sorted the list backwards with combining a filter and an entry in the search box

Icon Placement – Improved the exact location of feature icons on the map that appeared to be in slightly different locations depending on the zoom level

ESRI Integration – Correctly handle features that have a name greater than 25 characters

Cybertracker Integration – Fixed a couple of issues that resulted in Cybertracker being unable to correctly get the reports from EarthRanger

Dynamic Choices IDs – Fixed an issue that was displaying the ID of a dynamic choice instead of the display name

Google Satellite Maps – Integrated a change to Google Satellite Map base layer to remove underlying map labels that were creating confusion
